***PRweb* v2.3 Summary of Changes**

The following release notes outline the changes implemented in AcquiLine *PRweb* v2.3. The changes for *PRweb* v2.3 are organized into the following areas:

- System Administration
- Functional User

System Administration

Managers' Rights

The Groups system administration task currently allows an administrative user to select and deselect users as managers of one or more groups. The manager's rights have been enhanced to now include the ability to transfer documents from and to individuals under their management.

Administrator View/Delete of User-Defined Route Templates

Routing templates have been enhanced to allow system administrators the ability to display user-defined routing templates. System administrators can now view, edit, and delete user-defined route templates.

All File Transfer

System administrators now have the ability to quickly transfer workload from one user to another. This feature was designed for the unilateral transfer of documents located in the Drafts, Inbox, Outbox, and Archive folders from one user to another to facilitate staff turnover. Upon successful transfer, the user is automatically removed from all groups and routing templates and is disabled.

Configurable Funding Templates

The Funding Templates SA task has been enhanced to allow sites to create site-level configurable funding templates. This grants the site greater flexibility to make changes if the corresponding payment system directs modification. For Army sites, *PRweb* v2.3 includes the new Army funding strip supported by PD² 4.2 Increment 1.

NAICS Code

Under the **Site Preferences** task, system administrators can configure the North American Industry Classification Standards (NAICS) codes that end users may select on a PR. Users may view and select a NAICS code that has been added using this task. If a system administrator removes a NAICS code, users are notified when opening a line item that once contained the NAICS code.

Integration

PRweb v2.3 is now using the standard PD² Adapter for *PRweb*-PD² Integration.

Functional User

PR Modification

The PR Modification enhancement has been added to allow PRs to be modified using a formal change document. PR Modifications are created from the conform copy of the PR and may be edited, routed, and approved in the same manner as the PR. Some of the PR Modifications features include:

- Amount of Mod estimated quantity and cost
- New Totals estimated quantity and cost
- Unique PR Modification icon

NSN Search

The PR has been enhanced to include a National Stock Number (NSN) search feature. Users have the ability to search for existing NSNs and select the NSN to be included on the line item. Users also have the ability to manually enter NSNs on line items.

Multiple Deliveries

Currently PD² v4.2 Increment 1 supports multiple deliveries for a line item. As an enhancement, *PRweb* allows users to view multiple deliveries that were added to the PR while it was in PD². Users may view required delivery, ADC, and AFATA dates along with quantity and shipping addresses for each delivery.

When multiple deliveries exist on a PR, the Required Delivery Date, ADC, AFATA, and Period of Performance fields are removed from the **Detail** tab of the PR. Also, the Shipping Address field is removed from the **Shipping** tab.

NAICS selection

On the **Description** tab, the PR has been enhanced to allow users to select a North American Industry Classification Standards (NAICS) code for each line item.

Job Order Numbers

The following enhancements have been made to job order number functionality:

- The user ID of the creator is no longer associated with the job order number. Therefore, in the **Funding** window, other *PRweb* users may search for and select newly-created job order numbers created by another user.
- The expiration date has been added to the job order number search.
- Duplicate job order numbers that have unique expiration dates may be created, searched for, and selected on a line item.

Local Info

The PR has been enhanced to include a **Local Info** tab. The Local Info tab allows users to enter information that is site-specific on each PR. The Local Info labels that are displayed on each PR are configured via the PD² Local Info SA task and may be updated by the site as needed. Users also have the ability to refresh or update the Local Info configuration if they choose to display the latest system administrator changes.

Out of Office

The user's desktop has been enhanced with the Out of Office feature. This allows the user to enter dates that they are out of office along with a Forward Workload to *PRweb* user. When a user routes a document to the Out of Office user, the document is automatically forwarded to the Forward Workload to *PRweb* user. Once the Last Day Out of Office has passed, documents routed to the Out of Office user are no longer forwarded.

Manager Re-Direct

Manager's rights have been enhanced to allow the ability to transfer ownership of a PR from one user to another. The manager has transfer access to all Draft, Inbox, and Outbox documents for users in their designated management group.
